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## PRESCHOOL DASHBOARD PLACARD NEEDED for PARKING

Preschool families are authorized to park in the lot to the north of our entrance, **BUT MUST HAVE THE PROPER CARD DISPLAYED ON YOUR DASHBOARD.** Parking monitors will not allow any other vehicles into parking spots without our **BRIGHT GREEN PLACARD.** If you still need one for the first day, please stop by our office for one.

## USING ENROLLSY

Now is the time to have your account all set up and a PIN set for first day check in.

If you have already accessed your account, set up a password, and downloaded the app on your phones, then the next step is simple.

- While your app is open, tap the person bubble in the top right corner of the screen.
- Click on MY ACCOUNT
- Click on RESET PIN
- Create a 4-digit PIN and click SET

When you arrive each day, you will check-in [Green Button] on the white computers. And again at pick-up time you will check-out [Red Button] on the white computers.

Type in *Last 4-digits of your account phone* entered first... Then *4-digit PIN* next. Select correct child, and class, then green/in or red/out button. Ask us for help if needed.

## Full-day student LUNCH TIME

If you need a HOT lunch for your child, you **MUST** mark option A or B on the lunch clipboard next to the fish tank.

You will also see a clipboard asking for PIZZA count by Tuesday each week.



## FIRST 3 Days of preschool are INDOOR, CLASSROOM DROP-OFF.

Starting Monday, August 7<sup>th</sup>, students will go to the playground for drop-off between 7:40 am. – 8:05 am.

Classroom pick-up is between 11:00 – 11:15 a.m. for morning students, and between 3:00 and 3:15 p.m. for full-day students.
